World's largest arid limestone karst is threatened!




The Nullarbor Plain harbours a spectacular hidden world of ancient caves, blowholes, dolines, and rock holes, of staggering beauty, exceptional scientific values, and priceless cultural importance.



The proposed Western Green Energy Hub - 3,000 wind turbines, 25 million solar panels, 15,000 square kilometres - is utterly incompatible with the fragile and globally significant Nullarbor karst.

Industrialisation of the Nullarbor Plain will permanently damage this unique and fragile karst landscape which holds superlative natural and cultural values of World Heritage significance.



It is imperative that this enormous, proposed energy project is developed on an alternative location which is NOT on the Nullarbor limestone.


